

ADMISSION SCHOLARSHIP FOR INDIGENOUS STUDENTS IN BACCALAUREATE NURSING PROGRAMS

Quebec Indigenous Research Chair in Nursing (CRASIQ)'s mission is to foster Indigenous health equity and cultural safety in Quebec through the decolonization of health professionals' education and practice. CRASIQ will award scholarships to Indigenous students newly enrolled in a baccalaureate nursing program at a Quebec university. These scholarships are designed to encourage Indigenous nursing students to persevere and succeed in their studies.

AMMOUNT: two 1 000\$ scolarships

DEADLINE: 30 octobre 2023

ELIGIBILITY

- Be an Indigenous student enrolled full-time or part-time* in a baccalaureate nursing program at a Quebec university.
- At the time of application, the student must have been accepted into the program, before the start of the first year, or be in the program's first year.
- Identify as First Nations, Métis or Inuit.
 - * To be eligible, students must be enrolled in at least three courses of three credits each.

Applicants who do not meet all these requirements will not be eligible for the scholarship.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The student has demonstrated perseverance throughout his/her academic career.
- Importance of the student's sense of belonging to his/her community or nation of origin
- Originality and quality of the application

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED (ELECTRONIC COPY)

A cover letter of no more than 2 pages. This letter should include a summary of the
applicant's academic background, connection to their home community or nation, and
career aspirations in the field of nursing.











- Completed and signed application form.
- A photocopy of a status card or a letter of recommendation from a community member attesting to the applicant's ties to their community.
- Proof of enrolment in the Bachelor of Nursing program at a Quebec university.
- Transcripts of all completed university terms if the student has already begun undergraduate studies (official transcripts are not required).
- Curriculum vitae

KNOWLEDGE TRANSFER

No later than one year after receiving their grant, funded students will be asked to give a presentation on the topic of their choice at CRASIQ's Lunch and Learn conferences, during CRASIQ's annual Forum, or at any other activity organized by the Chair.

CUMULATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Combination with any other grant is permitted.

SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION

Send the application as a single PDF document to: crasiq@umontreal.ca no later than October 30, 2023.

RESULT ANNOUNCEMENT AND PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants will receive a reply to their application by December 2023 at the latest. Recipients will receive their scholarship in one instalment, due before February 2024. Please note that students must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 credits at the time they receive their grant.
